## Bryn Mawr firm installs solar hot water system

Lindy Property Management Gateway Towers Building C in Philadelphia sports a newly installed 18-panel roof top Solar Hot Water system in two rows of 10 feet by 36 feet (visible from the parking lot) and a 3,200-gallon basement hot water storage tank.

Rushforth Solar LLC in Bryn Mawr designed and installed this Solar Hot Water system to pre-heat hot water for the 100 apartment units at Gateway Towers Building C.

This is the second Rushforth Solar Hot Water project for

Lindy Properties. Their Fountain Gardens in Northeast Philadelphia has one of the largest Solar Hot Water systems for an apartment building complex in the Philadelphia Area.

Rushforth Solar LLC designs and installs Solar Hot Water for buildings that use lots of hot tap water in the Greater Philadelphia Area.

In 2008, Penn Future honored Rushforth Solar LLC with a Green Power Pioneer Award and The Sustainable Development Fund of The Reinvestment Fund awarded Rushforth Solar with a

competitive grant.

Alan Rushforth was the first Solar Thermal Installer in the Eastern Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware region to receive the NABCEP (North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners) solar thermal certification. Rushforth Solar is also accredited with Better Business Bureau (BBB), registered with DEP PA Sunshine Program and is a participating energy service provider (ESP) with Sustainable Energy Fund (ESF).
