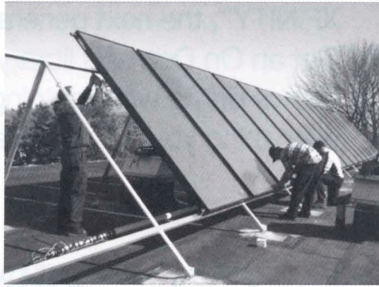
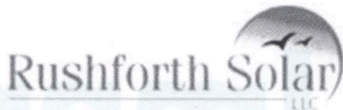


Rushforth Solar Update

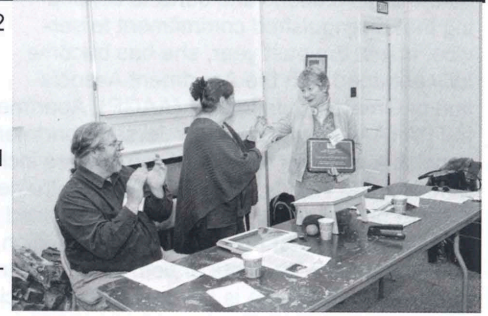

Jan Rushforth Recipient of DCVA Ribbon of Green Award

An active volunteer for 12 years at the former Haverford State Hospital (HSH), Jan was a key player to help preserve green space at Haverford Reserve: 80% of the 207 acres of the former HSH were preserved for natural green space and community active recreation. Her co-writing and administering a grant led to design and building of walking trails and an environmental assessment. Jan was also recognized at the Feb 5, 2011 ground breaking for the indoor recreation - environmental center to be built at Haverford Reserve.



As a Haverford Township 4th Ward Commissioner in 2008, Jan's focused goals for environmental progress and expanding recycling contributed to township wide Single Stream Recycling, pick up of yard waste, and an Inventory and Community Action Plan to reduce Green House Gas Emissions in Haverford Township. She also arranged for Township recognition to honor several outstanding women of the community. As an active DCVA volunteer for the last decade, Jan presided in 2009 when the DCVA celebrated its 25th Anniversary with the development of a commemorative map and a celebratory luncheon to honor our roots and strengthen our future.

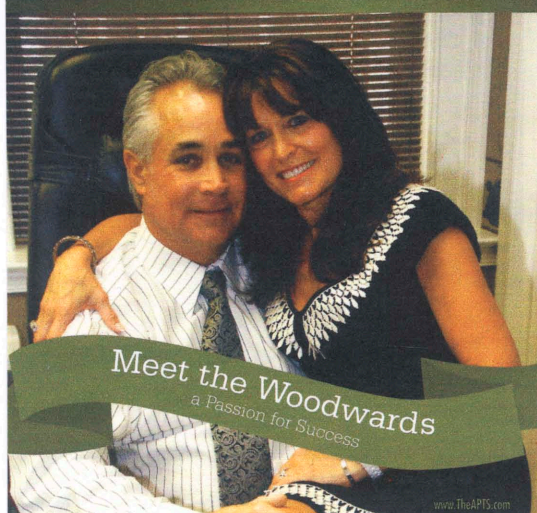
